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Dear Parents/Guardians

Thank you for your interest in our Brainline Facilitation Program. This document includes everything you will need to know about how we operate and what you can expect going forward. Please note that we do not provide formal schooling, we merely facilitate the process of learning for Brainline students.

Henley High School has identified a need for quality education at an affordable price. Therefore, we have partnered with Brainline to offer an IEB accredited curriculum. We facilitate learning in a relaxed, but structured environment, assisting each student to achieve their academic goals. At Henley, we blend virtual learning with a classroom environment for a better individual learning experience. Parental interaction and involvement is an important part of this type of system.

We offer small classes that allow for individual attention, where students are supervised and mentored by a suitably qualified and highly motivated invigilator. We have the printing, scanning and wifi facilities available for successful learning to take place. In addition to the support of the invigilator, we acknowledge the importance of social interactions and building friendships. As a result, we promote and encourage collaboration and synergy between the students.

Venue and Times:

The Tutor Centre, is open from 7:30 – 13h30 Monday to Friday. Students will receive a scheduled timetable from Brainline, and virtually attend classes in accordance with it.

Curriculum:

Brainline is accredited by the Independent Examinations Board (IEB) and the Department of Education. The curriculum is an online correspondence course. Parents/Guardians need to register their child/ren directly with Brainline before admission into The Tutor Centre. The steps are attached to this document.

Brainline sets termly tasks and examinations, where are uploaded by the help of the invigilator, and marked by Brainline teachers. Brainline issues reports onto the student's online profile, after the completion of each term. The invigilator has access to each student's profile and can view the reports as well. We do not provide reports, but we do provide a qualified and registered invigilator to oversee the tests and examination processes.

Tuition Fees:

2022: R1500 p/m for the access to and use of our facilities (Monthly instalments for the months of January – November)

2023: R1600 p/m for the access to and use of our facilities (Monthly instalments for the months of January – November)

2024: R1700 p/m for the access to and use of our facilities (Monthly instalments for the months of January – November)

Curriculum Fees:

These are payable directly to Brainline and can be found on their website.

Brainline fees* are published on their website as follows:

Grade 8 – 9 IEB Aligned Course R 23 350.00 per annum (approx. R2 123 per month)

Grade 10 IEB Aligned Course R31 850.00 per annum (approx. R2 895 per month)

The above fees exclude textbooks and stationery costs.
