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Dear Parent/Guardian,

Thank you so much for your enquiry. It is our pleasure to introduce the school to you.

Henley Primary School is a private, co-ed primary school. We have a strong academic tradition and all learners are encouraged to work to the best of their own ability. Classes are small and learners are given individual attention. We strive to create a happy atmosphere, providing for the talents of each child. Learners are encouraged to develop a caring and responsible attitude towards each other.

The school currently consists of 170 learners from different cultural, ethnic and religious backgrounds. Henley Primary School is a Christian School and all learners will be exposed to the Christian ethos. In appreciation of our social and cultural diversity as a South African educational institution, we welcome and respect staff and students who are believers of different faiths and denominations.

Grades offered:

- Grade RR - The learner must turn 5 in the year applying for Grade RR.
- Grade R - The learner must turn 6 in the year applying for Grade R.
- Grade 1 – 7

Each learner enrolling at Henley Primary School would need to do a skills based competency test. The assessment is to help identify any areas of concern a learner may have and this will enable our teachers to better assist your child. There is no need to study for this assessment as it consists of grade related questions.

Extra-mural activities:

Grade RR – Grade 1:

Cultural program: The activities can change each term for variety, currently we offer Sewing Club, Lego Club, Art & Crafts, Music Club, Little Scientists, Public Speaking and Drama. Learners also have the opportunity to take part in the Alberton Eisteddfod.

Sports program: we offer athletics, netball, soccer, cricket, hockey and archery.

Grade 4 – Grade 7:

Cultural program: The activities can change each term for variety, currently we offer Drama, Choir, Computer Wizzes and Arts & Crafts. Learners also have the opportunity to take part in the Alberton Eisteddfod.

Sports program: we offer athletics, netball, soccer, cricket, hockey and archery.

Academic Support:

Academic support is offered to all learners struggling with a concept. This is done after school at no expense to the parents.

Due to the impact Covid-19 has had on the educational system, it has severely impacted our Foundation Phase (Grade R – Grade 3) learners. Many of these young learners have missed out on some of the fundamental building blocks needed. We are proud to be offering free Remedial classes from 2023.

School fee structure:

I have attached our school fee structure and an application form. The fee clearance form needs to be handed to your school bursar and submitted with your application along with the following documents:

1. Learners birth certificate
2. Learners recent report
3. Identity documents/passport of learners parents

Please note: No assessment will be booked without receiving all the necessary documentation

School fees are always payable in advance and exclude the following:

- Textbooks and stationery – certain textbooks for Grade R to Grade 7 will be invoiced on statement
- School uniform are for the parents account.

Enrolment fee:

Upon acceptance to Henley Primary School there is a once-off non-refundable fee of R3300 payable per child.

Aftercare Centre

We have an Aftercare Centre on our property where we aim to provide a well-supervised, yet relaxed and fun facility for your child. Educators on duty will assist learners with their homework. Your child will also have the freedom to join any school activity and then attend aftercare for a prepared lunch as well as a mid-afternoon snack. Our Aftercare Centre is open every school holiday but will close from the 15th of December.
